Introduction

- Understand the relationship between ESG, corporate governance, ethics, and stakeholder expectations.
- Evaluate executive compensation and performance through an ESG perspective.

- Strengthen oversight of supply-chain, human-rights, social, and reputational risks.
- Understand the Board's role in sustainability transformation and net-zero strategies.
- Enhance Board-level decision-making through ESG scenario analysis and emerging-risk assessment.
- Develop practical frameworks for strengthening ESG governance within the organization.
